Don't think of it as just another bank

ne of the first tenants at Progress Ridge Town-Square in Beaverton, Rivermark Community Credit Union, is happy to help the community and, at the same time, provide a number of valuable and handy financial services.

Manager Randy Bresee said his branch is fitting well into the surrounding community.

"It's an excellent area for us to be in," Bresee said. "It's a new




