

Holiday dinner time The team at New Seasons is ready to offer ideas to help make your holiday meal extra special

hanksgiving is over and we switch our attention to Christmas. It's never too early to start planning the holiday dinner. New Seasons Market at Progress Ridge TownSquare has the food, staff and expertise to help you create a dinner that will leave your friends and family richly satisfied.

Store manager Michael Butterfield is getting his staff ready to assist customers.

"We'll have everything to offer, from pumpkin pies to Christmas trees, from turkeys to hams," Butterfield said. "Anything fresh, organic, you name it, we'll have it. And if there's something we don't have, tell us, we'll go out and get it."

Butterfield enjoys the energy that the Christmas season brings to New Seasons Market.

"This is my favorite time to work. It really is," Butterfield added. "It's a holiday about family. Food is a big part of that - It's the one time of the year even people who don't cook like to come to the store."

The meat department is a big part of New Seasons Market. You can find standing rib roasts, pork tenderloins, pork loin roasts, turkeys, geese, duck, lamb racks and lamb legs. The standing rib roast is a more popular choice, according to meat and seafood manager Nathan Ball.

Seafood choices include lobster tails, fresh oysters and stuffed salmon.

"We take a whole, clean

salmon, then take out the rib cage and put a filling in there," Ball said, adding that an artichoke stuffing goes well with coho salmon (a fish New Seasons typically uses).

Breads and bakery items are a must for the holiday meal. Ask them about French baguettes, ciabatta or Parker House rolls.

Bakery Manager Chris Westerfield said stollen is a bread that's available in December. "It's definitely a sweet bread," Westerfield said, noting the bread is covered with powdered sugar and contains dried fruit, candied fruit and raisins.

Another popular Christmas choice is pane dolce, a brown bread with dried cranberries and orange peel.

"On the pastry side, we have apple pies, marionberry pies, pumpkin pies, and pecan pies," Westerfield said. "Pumpkin pies remain popular throughout the holidays."

The produce department provides wonderful fruit and vegetable choices, including cranberries, chestnuts, satsuma mandarins and an impressive selection of wild mushrooms. Fruit and veggie platters are also offered.

Freshness is stressed at New Seasons Market. Christi Reed, New Seasons Market nutritionist, said, "The fresher your food is, the more nutritious it is, especially when we are talking about produce."






