

Korean restaurant, salon to soon open in Parkway Village at Sherwood

Two new businesses – a Korean-style restaurant and full-service salon – are planning to open in Parkway Village at Sherwood in early January.

Koba Grill, which services healthy Korean food, and AritiZan Salon, a full-service salon, will go into the Gramor Development complex, which includes a Walmart superstore and will soon be home to a new Spaghetti Factory restaurant.

This will be the first Koba Grill ever built, according to owner Eun Ku, who is leasing 1,430 square feet of space for her restaurant. Eun said chose Parkway Village at Sherwood "because I saw how well the other restaurants are doing there."

She said the fact that the Spaghetti Factory is opening in the same complex greatly influenced her location decision.

"This will bring many people in," she said. "We can share customers. This is simply a great location."

Meanwhile, ArtiZan Salon is moving into a 1,300-square-foot retail space nearby. The salon offers hair coloring, styling, facials, waxing, threading and other services. This is the salon's first and only location as well. It will be run by business partners Brad Larson, who is the salon manager, and Farzana Bhutto, who will oversee the day-to-day business operations.

"We did an extensive search of centers throughout the metro-area and in the surrounding communities and decided the Parkway Village location would give us the greatest success," said Larson. "We like the other businesses already there and, we feel this will be a nice spot to open our first salon."
