

training classes we can get you into to get you properly set up and prepped," Dees said.


Dees added that the shop does not require masks and that they are doing beard trimmings again after they had stopped doing so as a COVID-19 precaution.

# Helping your backyard birds

Backyard Bird Shop provides advice on how to best assist the local bird population during and after nesting season

Backyard Bird Shop outreach coordinator Darlene Betat gets a kick out of observing the nuances of bird behavior — such as when the male chickadee will feed the female as a form of courtship. And she relishes when the birds trust her enough to take mealworms out of her hand.

But more importantly, Betat said seeing birds thrive and the local community protecting the bird habitat gives her hope that these creatures will continue to be around for future generations.

"It's not that simple but I absolutely love watching parents take care of baby birds. You are amazed at what you learn — the different communications birds have and you start to see patterns," Betat said.

Backyard Bird Shop located in West Linn Central Village can help local residents garner a connection with bird habitats and help sus

with bird habitats and help sustain birds during nesting season and after.

During the nesting season, which ends in the summer, Betat said it's important for locals to provide birds with food, shelter and water. Some products the store sells include suet feeders, sumflower seeds for seed eaters like finches and live mealworms. Also providing nesting shelves can be a very helpful option. Some birds will not get into bird houses but will build a nest on a shelf, Betat explained. The shop also sells nest materials people can provide animals like plant or animal fibers.

"I look forward every year to the nesting season where I can watch hummingbirds take the nesting material I have offered. It gives me happiness to see them take a mouthful of materials." Betat said

During the late summer and early fall, Betat noted that water is most scarce and that one of the best things a local birdenthusiast can do is provide water for birds.

"A fountain is huge because it makes a sound (similar to) a creek and birds coming over will investigate any water sound whether it's a drip or a burble," Betat said.

Betat added that there will be more birds around post-nesting season so people should continue to keep healthy portions of food available. She further advised people to avoid getting too close to nests as birds will see that as a threat and young birds who aren't ready to leave the nest may do so out of fear, thus putting them at risk. Also, do not approach birds

who are struggling to fly, Betat added, unless they are visibly injured. Betat also said to try to avoid disrupting bird habitats when undergoing outdoor improvement projects.

"If a bird is making sounds near you they likely are upset that you are close to the nest," Betat said.

Along with materials and products to help you create a healthy bird habitat, Backyard Bird Shop has information and knowledgeable employees who can assist you.

## Central Village practices are expanding

Advance Sports & Spine and Advance Dental Arts undergo double remodel

One year ago, Advance Sports & Spine and Advance Dental Arts began planning a remodel of their joint space to allow each practice to treat patients more efficiently.

Husband and wife Kim Wright, a dentist, and Nelson Tenoso, a physical therapist, opened their practices next door to one another in West Linn Central Village in 2008.

Then, in 2017, Wright was looking to ex-oand Advance Dental Arts and bought an-

to Advance Sports & Spine closed, allowing the physical therapy office to take over some of the studio space and Advance Dental to expand into the physical therapy office. Club Pilates, which moves in next to Advance Sport & Spine later this year, will

be about half the size of the former Forge

Hot Yoga location. "It really made sense for us to stay here so we sold the other property and we're expanding here," Wright said. Once the remodel is complete, Sport &

Spine will have one more treatment room, a new office and lobby and the treatment rooms will open up into a new gym, allowing the therapists to work more efficiently with their patients, physical therapist Jeff Cox explained. "We're very functionallybased exercise programming," Cox said. "We'll have a more efficient space to have people moving to restore mobility and function."

Cox said the remodel also allowed the physical therapists to take stock of their equipment. He said Sport & Spine had sold older equipment that wasn't frequently used and purchased new equipment that

Advance Dental will have additional office space and two more operatories, allowing clinical staff to see more patients, and the practice's two dentists, Wright and Kristan Rodriguez, to work simultane-

"We're excited to be able to have both of us working," Wright said.

With more space, Advance Dental will also need more clinical staff.
"Hopefully in September we'll have ou

whole team in place and we can really hit

the ground running from an expanded pace," Wright said.

Cox and Wright said the remodel process

has been slow-going. Construction was initially supposed to begin in December or January but did not start until late March.

Still, both practices are excited for the work to be done. The Advance Sport & Spine remodel is expected to finish in early August. The expanded Advance Dental


